### **By Car**

#### **From the North via Birmingham and Oxford or from the South from London on the M40**

Come off the M40 at Junction 5 and follow the signs into Stokenchurch. Go through the village and then turn right on the B482 signed 'Cadmore End, Lane End, Marlow'. After two miles, The Tree will be on your left.

### **By Train**

#### **From London Marylebone (and from the North and Midlands)**

There are no suitable bus services to Cadmore End so if you come by train you will need to get a taxi to The Tree. The most convenient station is High Wycombe, which is on the Chiltern Railways line from Marylebone to Birmingham and the Midlands. Citi Cars are right opposite the station - Tel: 01494 515555. It is about seven miles to Cadmore End and the cost will be around £15.00 - £20.00.

#### **From London Paddington (and from the West)**

Marlow is on the First Great Western Line from London Paddington to Reading. Change onto the Marlow Line at Maidenhead. Marlow station is simply a halt platform with no booking office or taxi service so you will need to book a taxi in advance, if you use this route. It is about six miles from Cadmore End and will cost around £10.00 - £15.00.
