Itinerary

Day 1 -If you can arrive early, meet 2pm for a walk around Salisbury including an optional tour of the

Cathedral. Otherwise meet from 5pm at the college.

Day 2 - Salisbury to Broughton - approx. 11 miles

Day 3 - Broughton to Oliver's Battery - approx. 9/10 miles

Day 4 - Oliver's Battery to Winchester - approx. 3 miles + optional tour of Winchester Cathedral.

Please book trains from 4.30pm.

Travel Directions to Sarum College

Walking & Cycling

Sarum College is in the centre of Salisbury and is within a 15-minute walk of both the rail and bus stations. If you are cycling there is a small bike shed located to the right (Eastern side) of the college.

Public transport

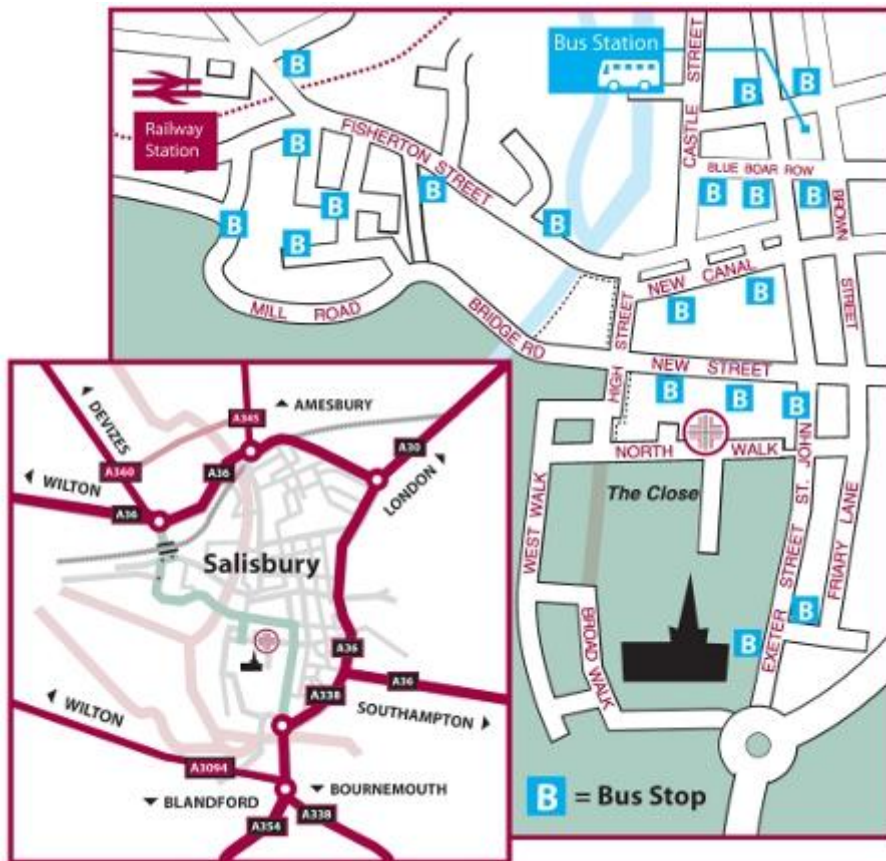
Public transport links to Salisbury are excellent and rail and bus stations are very close to Sarum College.

The train services to and from Salisbury are frequent with direct trains to London, Southampton, Portsmouth, Bath, Bristol, Cardiff and Exeter.

The city also has an extensive bus network with five park & ride sites located at all the main routes into Salisbury. More details about Salisbury Park & Ride can be found on Wiltshire Council's website. See map below for the location of the rail and bus stations, and bus stops within the City Centre.

By Car

Car parking at Sarum College is very limited and is available on a first come first serve basis. On entering The Close at Salisbury you may be stopped by a Car Park attendant for the Cathedral – if you mention you are staying at Sarum College you should be able to drive straight through and park at the College. Alternatively there is a small car park within the cathedral close, along with others in the city centre. If you do come by car The High Street entrance is the only way to drive into The Close. Satellite navigation users are warned that these often direct you to St. Ann’s Gate, which is for pedestrians only. Some systems are more effective when “North Walk” is entered as the street name rather than “The Close”.

From St Paul’s Roundabout

Leave the roundabout at the exit after St Paul’s Church signposted for the railway station. Go under the railway bridge and turn sharp right at the mini-roundabout towards the station. Turn left at the next mini-roundabout at the station entrance. Follow Mill Road, Crane Bridge Road and Crane Street to the High Street traffic lights. Turn right into High Street and once inside The Close turn left into North Walk. Sarum College is on your left opposite Bishop’s Walk.

From New Road Roundabout

Take the City exit from the roundabout and follow Exeter Street into St John Street, keeping in the left-hand lane. Opposite the White Hart Hotel, turn left at the traffic lights into New Street. Turn

left at the High Street traffic lights into the Close, then turn left into North Walk. Sarum College is on your left opposite Bishop's Walk.
