By Car to Grasmere in the Lake District

If coming from the south: M6 -> Windermere -> Ambleside -> Grasmere

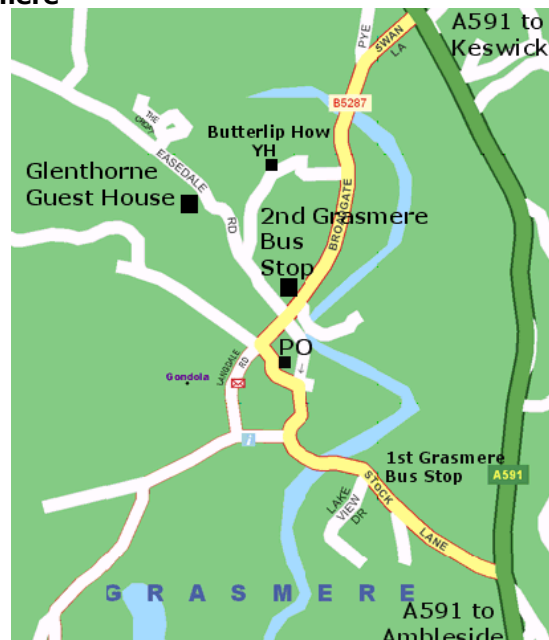
◆ Leave the M6 at Junction 36. When you reach Windermere stay on the A591 along the top of the town, following signs to Ambleside & Keswick, rather than heading into Windermere itself. When you reach Ambleside stay on the A591, following the 1-way system around and following any signs to Keswick, Rydal and Grasmere.

◆ Stay on the A591 through Rydal village, alongside Rydal Water, and then alongside Grasmere (the lake). Take the first turning on the left signed to Grasmere village. Ignore all car parks, and continue into the village. You will pass the Moss Grove Hotel and then the post office - both on your right. After the post office the "main" road bends round to the right, and just after you have followed it round there is a turning on the left sign-posted Easedale road. Take this turning!

◆ Glenthorne Guest House is a short way up this road on the left, a couple of bends after the YHA youth hostel. It has its own spacious car park (sharp turn in on the left!)

If coming from the North: M6 -> A66 -> A591

◆ If coming from Scotland or Newcastle, you might consider coming via the A66 from Junction 40 of the M6, then take A591 towards Windermere & Grasmere. Take the first turning off the A591 to Grasmere village, and watch out for Easedale Rd on your right just after a row of shops on the left. Follow the rest of the directions above.

By Train to Windermere

From London the journey takes approx 3.30hr.

From Birmingham: The journey takes about 2.40hr.

From Windermere station to Grasmere

Bus service (555 & 599) between Windermere Station and Grasmere. Tell the driver you wish to get off at the second bus stop, next to Easedale Rd. Please check the Traveline website for an up to date timetable:

Glenthorne Guest House is approx 5 mins from the bus stop. Walk up Easedale Rd, around 2 short bends, and it's on the left.
